Our commitment

We create a safe, caring environment where children are listened to, respected and protected. All staff have a duty to recognise and respond to possible abuse, neglect, exploitation or harm.

How we keep children safe

- Suitable staff recruitment checks are completed before staff begin work.
- Staff receive safeguarding training and know how to report concerns.
- Attendance, injuries, changes in behaviour and children's comments are recorded and reviewed.
- Children are supported to understand feelings, boundaries and how to seek help in an age-appropriate way.

If we are worried about a child

We will normally speak with parents or carers. However, we may contact Wiltshire Integrated Front Door, the police or another safeguarding agency without consent when this is necessary to protect a child. We will not delay a referral while waiting for the DSL.
