

Illness and Medication

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Children should attend when they are well enough to enjoy nursery and take part safely.

If a child becomes unwell

We will comfort and supervise the child, contact a parent or carer and ask for prompt collection where necessary. We will call emergency services when urgent medical help is needed.

Medication

- Medication must be supplied in its original labelled container with clear instructions.
- Written parental permission is required before administration, except in a life-threatening emergency.
- Administration is recorded and shared with the parent or carer.
- Long-term or emergency medication may require an individual healthcare plan.
